SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

General information

When in doubt or if symptoms are observed, get medical advice.

After inhalation

Provide fresh air.

After contact with skin

After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of water. Take off immediately all contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse. Call a physician immediately.
